28.01 DEFINITIONS.

28.02 NEVADA SENIOR COMMUNITY CENTER BOARD CREATED.

A Nevada Senior Community Center Board is hereby created to advise the Council on the facilities and activities held at the facility.

28.03 BOARD ORGANIZED.

The Board shall consist of five members, all residents of Nevada, appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Council, for five-year terms with one term ending each year. The Board shall choose a Chair and Vice Chair every year. Members shall serve without compensation, but may receive reimbursement for their actual expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment. No person may serve more than ten consecutive years.

28.04 DUTIES OF THE COMMISSION.

1. The Board shall be responsible to recommend to the Council policies for the control and management of the building. The Board shall review any management proposals and make recommendations to the Council.

2. The Board shall recommend fees and charges for the use of the building or any part of the building to the Council for approval. The Board shall annually review all fees charged for the use of the building and recommend any changes to the Council. All changes to fees shall be approved by resolution of the Council and included in the Appendix to this Code of Ordinances and shall either be posted at the facility or available upon request at the facility or at the City Clerk's office.

3. The Board shall recommend rules and regulations for the use of the facility, subject to approval of the Council. Such rules shall either be posted on or in the facility or otherwise publicized in a manner to provide adequate notice to the using public. The Board shall make a written report to the Council of its activities at a minimum of once a year. The Board shall make a written report to the City Administrator on a quarterly basis on the attendance and uses of the facility.

4. The Board shall recommend to the Council for approval any programs and activities to enhance the lives of Nevada's seniors.

28.05 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, WINE AND BEER.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code of Ordinances or the Code of Iowa, it is unlawful for any person to possess, sell or provide beer, wine, or alcoholic liquor in the Nevada Senior Community Center.
